### **General Role**

- Provide an experience for licensed pharmacists, students and interns in a non-traditional setting.
- Practical dispensing and management in a dispensing physician practice paired with professional interaction with other medical professionals.
- Set in the most underserved population of Milwaukee creating special challenges for healthcare providers.

### **Specific tasks**

- Work in a multidisciplinary primary care setting for uninsured patients.
- Utilize non-traditional medication dispensing and tracking methods.
- Guide providers in proper medication strength and dosing schedules & recognize incorrect prescribing, over prescribing and under prescribing.
- Review patient profiles to identify potential interactions, therapeutic duplication or excessive duration of therapy.
- Guide therapeutic substitution and recommend appropriate substitutions based off of available medications
